

## Prepare your piglets for the post-weaning diet

Piglets are weaned before their digestive systems have developed sufficiently to digest the vegetable proteins and starches found in starter feed. A quality pre-starter offered prior to weaning is essential in order to prime the piglet's digestive system so that they can digest these nutrients post-weaning.

The pre-starter Neopigg Go! is highly palatable. It is formulated with carefully selected raw materials that are specially blended to encourage the development of the digestive system. This has the potential to ensure good intakes in the lactation period and to drive performance and efficiency post-weaning. Neopigg Go! helps to smooth the weaning process and minimise any post-weaning dips in performance.

- 1.8 mm pellet for maximum feed intake
- Reduces weaning dip as piglets are better prepared for a starter diet

- Uniform and highly palatable feed that contributes to improved feed intake


### FEEDING INSTRUCTIONS

Neopigg Go! should be offered to piglets from four days of age to the end of the farrowing period. Maximising pre-weaning feed intake is key, so feeding little and often is recommended.



The product has a good smell and it is a nice pellet. The piglets like it. They eat it like I eat a fillet steak – they really go for it! Our piglets that are fed on Neopigg Go! are more solid. When both farrowing rooms have 24 sows in each and approximately 12 piglets per sow I get through a bag of Neopigg Go! per room in the week up to weaning. And at weaning the piglets are 600g heavier than they were on a conventional creep feed. Post-weaning, I can pick out the piglets that have had Neopigg Go! Also, they eat the starter feed straight away with no dip in feed intake




All our staff comment on the nice smell of Neopigg Go! and piglet intakes in the farrowing crates are better than with other pre-starters we have tried, which is definitely part of the success of the product. Our piglets on Go! are consistently a third of a kilo heavier at weaning than they were on the old pre-starter. As we move them from the first stage of the post-weaning period to the second stage, at four weeks old, we are getting an extra 2kg on them. This is approximately a 10% increase in bodyweight. We don't see piglets refusing to eat in the first few days post-weaning or see any hairy pigs. This must at least be partially due to feeding Neopigg Go!
